

SCCC- IS MY FACE SHINING?

S - Scriptures

“When Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the covenant law in his hands, he was not aware that his face was radiant because he had spoken with the Lord.” Exodus 34: 29

C – Consideration

Moses spent, again, another forty days on Mount Sinai in God’s presence. He learned all the details to build the Tabernacle, and, “The LORD said to Moses, “Chisel out two stone tablets like the first ones, and I will write on them the words that were on the first tablets, which you broke.” When he came down the mountain his face was shining.

C = Commitment

This verse has reminded me that when I am praying, there is a change inside of me that eventually, others around me will note. The daily devotional of prayer and meditation on God’s words will make my face radiant, my heart joyful and my soul satisfied. Today, we are not limited like Israel, who couldn’t go up to the mountain, “Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body.” I have seen the transformation of an intercessor’s face in churches that I pastored. They are an inspiration and a reminder for me to pray and never give it up.

C – Call

Heavenly Father, thank you that we no longer need to hide from your presence. You have sent Jesus, your Son to die for us, to make peace between us. My God, help us – Your people to understand the blessings of prayer. Lord, show us the path of prayer; and will fill us with joy in Your presence. May people see our face shining because of Your glory in us. In Jesus’s name, I pray. Amen.
