## **S – Scriptures**

“If you, Lord, kept a record of sins, Lord, who could stand?”  
Psalm 130: 3

## **C – Consideration**

The psalmist showed the reality of all humanity: completely lost, and devastated by sin. In the same book, David wrote: “For troubles without number surround me; my sins have overtaken me, and I cannot see. They are more than the hairs of my head, and my heart fails within me.” “My guilt has overwhelmed me like a burden too heavy to bear.” Psalm 40: 12, 38: 4. He did not hide like Adam and Eve but, he understood that he was incapable to deal with the biggest problem of his soul. Therefore, as he keeps praying he says: “I wait for the Lord, my soul waits for the Lord more” (v. 5-6). Finally, he finished his prayer with the amazing truth that is found in the gospel. “He himself will redeem Israel from all their sins.” (v. 8)

## **C – Commitment**

In my journey as a follower of Jesus, there will be times when I will have to remind myself that God doesn't remember my sins anymore. He had compassion on me, He sent his only Son Jesus to redeem my soul, He paid the
